SEAG Entrance Assessment

SEAG Outcomes are available online by 8.00am on Saturday 27th January 2024.

To access the results, parents will need to log on to their SEAG Dashboard, using the email address and password which were used to register their child. No other email address will work. SEAG advises that every parent should log on before 27th January to check that the correct details are being used. If a password has been forgotten, a new password can be requested online. If the email address being used is not the one originally used then the parent will need to email admin@seagni.co.uk for help before 27th January, providing the name and UPN of the pupil.

New Information relating to SEAG Outcomes

SEAG have added two new documents to the "Resources" area of the "Guidance for Parents" section of our website.

"SEAG Outcomes - a comparison with historical AQE and PPTC Outcomes" is a two-page document; before the "Comparison" tables there are two other sections "SEAG Outcomes – what they mean" AND "What TSAS or Band will a pupil need to gain a Year 8 place in a particular school for September 2024?"
